According to the Board of Education's Policy—Graduation Requirements, the Canyons Basic Diploma is available for extenuating circumstances upon administrative approval, subject to the following guidelines:

- 1. A plan for the 24-credit diploma must be developed for students in collaboration with a parent/guardian, counselor, principal and the student during the senior year after it is determined that the student requires alternative services or a student is identified as credit deficient;
- 2. It may only be awarded to seniors;
- 3. It may not be awarded early to graduates;
- 4. A diploma awarded for earning 24 credits will not qualify for an advanced or honors designation;
- 5. District and state requirements for core credits must be completed;
- 6. Diamond Ridge High School students will receive a Canyons Basic Diploma; and
- 7. Recipients of the Canyons Basic Diploma will walk with their peers and receive the basic diploma offered by each school.
