Attendance Goal: All students will attend school at least 95\% of the school year. In order to achieve this goal, students cannot miss more than 8 days of school for the year. All students who achieve this goal will receive an attendance certificate and be entered into a drawing for a new bicycle at the end of the school year.

There is a growing body of researc' 'wing that Chronic Absenteeism, usually defined by researchers as missing $10^{\prime}$ or $m<$ of the school year (including excused and unexcused absences), has significant $r_{1}$ rive effect on student achievement and may put a student at acader , risk. The goal fc Elementary is that all students miss no more than ${ }^{r}$, of the school year, in a effort to help every student be successful now and in the 'ure.

Too many absences-excused or unexcused-can keep students from succeeding in school and in life. How many are too many? I0\% of the school year-that's 18 missed days or 2 days a month-can knock students off track.

- Missing just a day or two every month can make it harder to learn to read by the third grade.
- Students with too many absences struggle to catch up, even with take-home assignments.

Prior to education leave, parents complete an Education Leave/Vacation Form for approval. Teachers will complete the "Work to Be Completed" section and determine a reasonable due date. School administration will verify education leave.
