

WAIVER OF PARTICIPATION

(Waiver of Participation in a Portion of the Curriculum or in an Activity)

Canyons School District (CSD) recognizes if a parent/legal guardian of a student, or a secondary student (grade 6-12) determines that the student's participation in a portion of the curriculum or in an activity would require the student to affirm or deny a religious belief or right of conscience, or engage or refrain from engaging in a practice forbidden or required in the exercise of a religious right or right of conscience, the parent or secondary student may request: (a) a waiver of the requirement to participate; or (b) a reasonable alternative that requires reasonably equivalent performance by the student of the secular objectives of the curriculum or activity in question. (See, Utah Code §53G-10-205 (2)).

Upon receipt of a request for a waiver, the school shall: (a) <u>waive</u> the participation requirement; (b) provide a <u>reasonable alternative</u> to the requirement; or (c) <u>notify the requesting party that participation is</u> required. (See, Utah Code §53G-10-205 (4)). See, Policy—600.02—Instructional Materials.
