A. Board Roundtable – Canyons Innovation Center

The Canyons Innovation Center will be building on the districts success and will serve as a catalyst for reimagining the future. Superintendent Robins provided an overview and update regarding the Innovation Center and how current programs as well as the CTEC enrollment trend will give direction to future opportunities for students. The Board of Education discussed CTE, CTECH, CC course maps leading to certificates and credentials. Superintendent Robins presented a timeline, and immediate needs.
