Topics to address – as they apply to your trip

- 1. Travel Arrangements
 - A. Flight arrangements airline and flight numbers, departure and arrival times, drop off and pick up
 - B. Hotel arrangements hotel name, address, and main phone number
 - C. Ground transportation busses, public transportation, costs
 - D. Discuss shipping or transporting equipment needed for the competitions
- 2. Student Conduct
 - A. Dress
 - B. Behavior
 - C. Drugs and alcohol
 - D. Student curfew
 - E. Hotel behavior and quiet time
 - F. Vandalism and theft
- 3. Itinerary
 - A. Day to day itinerary information
 - B. CTSO Web site information
 - C. Recreation activities (if applicable) determine what you will do as a group
- 4. Finances
 - A. Outline costs registration, hotel, meals, etc.
 - B. Determine fund raising activities if there will be any
 - C. State help if a state winner
- 5. Chaperones and parents attending
 - A. Introduce chaperones and provide cell phone and contact information
 - B. Role of parents going on the trip
 - C. Parents who are not designated chaperones need to be aware their students are the responsibility of the school district and need to check in with the chaperone
- 6. Vote Notarize
 - A. Pass around roll and vote
 - B. Offer notary service
