This direction aligns with the Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010, which directed the USDA to establish nutrition standards for all foods and beverages sold to students in school during the school day, including foods sold through school fundraisers. The standards provide support to encourage healthy options in school while providing a special exemption for infrequent fundraisers that do not meet the nutrition standards.
