

MICROFIBER CARE:

GETTING STARTED

Step 1. Sort Laundry By Wash Loads:

- Restroom Microfiber Towels & Floor Mops
- Light Duty Microfiber Towels, Floor Mops, & Dusters
- Microfiber Dust Mops (*Washed Every Friday*)
- Microfiber Wet Tube Mops (*Washed Every Friday*)
- Cotton Blue/Green Huck Towels

Unfold Towels Before Placing in Washing Machine
Never Wash Microfiber With Cotton



LAUNDRY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 2. Wash Laundry Using Correct Procedures:

- Do Not Over Load Washing Machine
- Use The Correct Amount of Laundry Detergent
- All Loads Should Be Set to Extra Large (*Maximum Water Level*)
- Select Cotton & Heavy (*Longest Wash Time*)
- Wash in Hot Water (*160°F Maximum*) for 25 Minutes

All Laundry Should Be Washed Twice:

First Wash - With Laundry Detergent

Second Wash - No Laundry Detergent



Step 3. Dry Laundry Using Correct Procedures:

- All Loads Should Be Set to Low Heat (*130 °F Maximum*)

Do Not Machine Dry:

Cotton String Wet Mops

ProTeam Vacuum Bags or Filters



REQUIRED CARE



- ***Wash Every Load Twice***
- ***Wash All Laundry Daily***
- ***Never Wash Microfiber With Cotton***
- ***Never Use Fabric Softener or Dryer Sheets***
- ***Do Not Store Microfiber in Washing Machine Overnight***
- ***Always Sort Dirty Laundry to Prevent Cross-Contamination***
- ***Never Use Bleach***
- ***Always Air-Dry Cotton String Wet Mops***
- ***Always Air-Dry ProTeam Bags or Filters***
- ***Clean Washing Machine After Each Use***
