


Interested in Make-up Credit?

Make-up credit will be offered in July at Entrada/CVHS for seniors only! Will you be a senior in the fall? Earn make-up credit/credit recovery for any high school core class you did not pass. CVHS lab classes available at the CTEC campus include Language Arts, Algebra I and II, Geometry, Biology, U.S. History, U.S. Government, Health, Financial Literacy, Earth Systems and more! Important Details



How do I register? Registration begins: 4/3/2012. Registration and payment will be accepted online at <u>http://canyons.revtrak.net</u>. Classes will be filled on a first come-first served basis.

Is there a cost? Yes. One non-refundable registration fee: \$25 Class fee: \$85 - PST only \$65 per all other classes

Credit card and check payments will be accepted. No refunds will be issued for registration fees; after the first day (June 18) no refunds will be issued for either the registration fee or course fees. Students requiring a fee waiver, or who have special circumstances, such as: English Language Learner, McKinney Vento, refugee, migrant, etc., will be assisted.

What is the format for 2012 summer semester? This year, a blended learning format will be utilized for all summer semester courses. Blending refers to a blend of face-to-face and online learning. For the weeks of June 18 and June 25 *mandatory in-person attendance* is required. Approximately 40 percent of the course content will be delivered online. All online coursework must be completed by July 13, 2012. For students who do not have home Internet access, Entrada will provide the use of its computer labs.

Where will classes be held? Most classes will take place at Entrada High School, 825 E. 9085 South. The PST class will be held at Mount Jordan Middle School, 9360 S. 300 East. You will receive a reminder e-mail message by June 15 confirming your class schedule and location.

What is the attendance policy? Due to the condensed scheduling of the summer semester, a strict attendance/tardy policy is mandatory. Students are allowed up to one absence and two tardies per class. If the attendance/tardy policy is violated, students will not receive a passing grade for the class, regardless of the reason.

Who can take classes? All incoming ninth-12th grade students for the 2012-2013 school year. Out-of-district students are welcome to register, as well.

How will I receive credit? Letter grades/credits will be posted to students' transcripts at their boundary schools. Failing grades also will be posted.
