



My VidCruiter interview is complete, what's happens next?

1. Congratulations, you are part of the Canyons School District K-12 Candidate Pool!

- Your profile is in the candidate pool for one recruiting season (November 1st, 2021 to November 1st, 2022).
- Profiles are organized by the License and/or Subject areas of your teaching license or degree:
 - **Elementary is separated into Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades.**
 - Email csdemployment@canyonsdistrict.org requesting a link to edit your application on Vidcruiter to add Grade levels you did not mark.
 - **Secondary is separated into the subject areas of Art, all CTE, Dance, Language Dual Immersion, English, Health, Mathematics, Music, PE, Sciences, Social Studies, Theatre, and World Languages.**
 - **You will only be added to the subject area that you currently have endorsements in, meet the guidelines for, or that you show you are graduating in that subject area.**
 - Elementary candidates can be added to the 6th grade pools for English, Math, History, or Science.
 - Email csdemployment@canyonsdistrict.org requesting a link to edit your application on Vidcruiter to add subject areas you did not mark.

2. Open positions are posted at <https://jobs.canyonsdistrict.org/hr/home.cfm>:

- Positions for the 2022-23 school year will be posted in mid-March and throughout the spring and summer months as openings occur.

3. Candidates **DO NOT apply for specific positions:**

- When a schools has an opening in the grade level you mark interest in or a subject area you are qualified for, your profile information is automatically sent to the school for consideration.
- If you see a job listing you are interested in, send the Principal an email to express your interest. This helps them know who is interested in jobs, especially for subject areas that tend to attract large amounts of candidates.
 - Emails are found on school webpages at www.canyonsdistrict.org/schools.
 - Schools have requested you do not call or go in person to express interest.
- When a school is ready to interview for a job opening, they only interview candidates in the pool with the required qualifications needed.
- Candidates may be contacted by phone or email for an interview.
 - *Make sure all of your contact information is up to date and if canyons district emails are ending up in your spam filter, that you have marked them not spam in your email setting. (Personal emails and phone numbers are better than school or work information when you are job hunting)*
