Topics Detail

- 1. Basic enrichment concepts** - Reptiles can get bored too, just like kids! In this class we will focus on our five senses compared to reptile senses. What is the same? What is different? We will introduce the children to a variety of our scaly friends and compare and contrast how we as humans enrich our own lives compared to how we can enrich our pet's lives.
- 2. Behavior in the wild vs enrichment at home** - In this class we will learn about reptile behavior in the wild. What kind of things enriches their brain naturally? They hunt, they sleep, they look for shelter and water, but what else might they do? We will talk about a variety of ways we can create enrichment for pet snakes, lizards, turtles and tortoises. We will focus on their natural behaviors like climbing, burrowing etc and figure out ways we can recreate those behavior opportunities for our pets.
- 3. Pet reptile enrichment outside the enclosure** - This week we will focus on things we can specifically do for the animals such as taking them outside for real sunlight, or adding smells to their enclosures. We will also focus on how we can enrich reptile diets and health by learning how to do research to find appropriate foods for a variety of reptiles. We can also provide safer feeding experiences for you and some reptiles by introducing training into their meals.
- 4. Enriching reptile environment with habitat design** - We will focus this last day on how to design reptile enclosures to match up with a variety of reptile natural habitats.

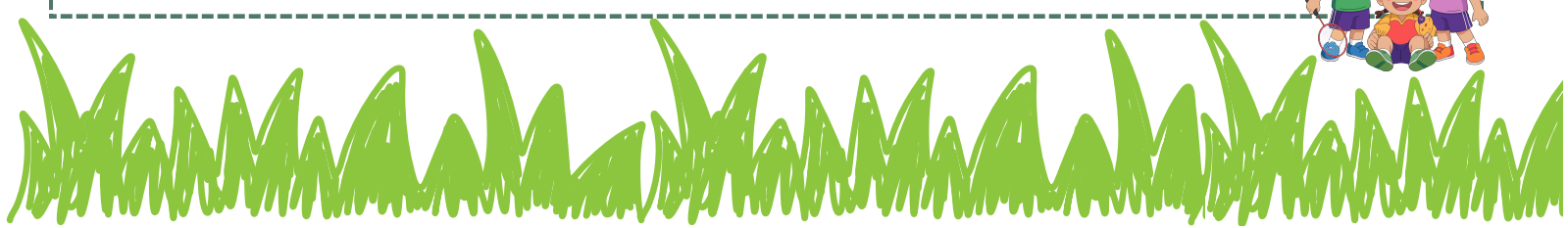

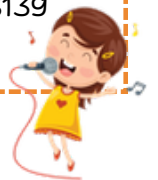
