Suicide Protocol At-a-Glance

Student is identified* as potentially at-risk for suicide:

• Comments, Social media posts, Writings/drawings/class assignments

*The person who identifies the student as at risk walks the student down to a suicide risk responder.



Student is referred *immediately* to a Suicide Risk Responder:

School Counselor

School Social Worker

School Psychologist

Suicide Risk Responder

- Speaks with student regarding concerns
- Completes Columbia-Suicide Severity Rating Scale (C-SSRS)
- Documents discussion and student's risk level according to C-SSRS and professional judgment (Low, Moderate, High)

Student is not to be left alone at any time.



Low Risk

(Non-Specific Suicidal Ideation only or denies all suicidal ideation)

- Call student's Parent/Guardian to notify of assessment & risk level
- Provide crisis line phone numbers and mental health resources/referrals
- Provide lethal means counseling to parent/guardian
- Complete Safety Plan with student and parent, if necessary
- Person who completed C-SSRS follows up with student and parent the next day, and as needed
- Person who completed C-SSRS completes Parent Notification of Threat form and gives copy to administration.

Moderate Risk:

(Current ideation with non-specific plan, no access to method, and no intent)

- Call student's Parent/Guardian to notify of assessment & risk level (Potential Conference with Parent/ Guardian)
- Discuss potential referral to mental health provider with parent/guardian (social worker, school psych, school based mental health, Canyons Family Center, outside resource).
- Provide crisis line phone numbers and mental health resources/referrals
- Provide lethal means counseling to parent/guardian
- Complete Safety Plan with student and parent
- Person who completed C-SSRS follows up with student and parent the next day, and as needed
- Person who completed C-SSRS completes Parent Notification of Threat form and gives copy to administration.
- If referring to school-based mental health, need to complete SST referral.

High Risk:

(Current Ideation with some intent, a specific plan, or an accessible method)

 Emergency Conference with Parent/ Guardians

Potential Next Steps for Referral after Speaking w/ Parents

- Seek consultation with other mental health staff
- **2.** Call MCOT (Mobile Crisis Outreach Team) (801) 587-3000
- **3.** Refer parents to Emergency Room (ER) for immediate evaluation
- Provide crisis line phone numbers and mental health resources/referrals.
- Provide lethal means counseling to parent/ quardian
- Discuss potential referral to mental health provider with parent/guardian (social worker, school psych, school based mental health, Canyons Family Center, outside resource).
- Complete Safety Plan with student & parent
- Person who completed C-SSRS follows up with student and parent the next day, and as needed
- Person who completed C-SSRS completes Parent Notification of Threat form and gives copy to administration.
- If referring to school-based mental health, need to complete SST referral.
